Where: Meet at 7AM at Starlite Tavern at the Richland Y if you want to tour to Prosser in time to have your car judged.

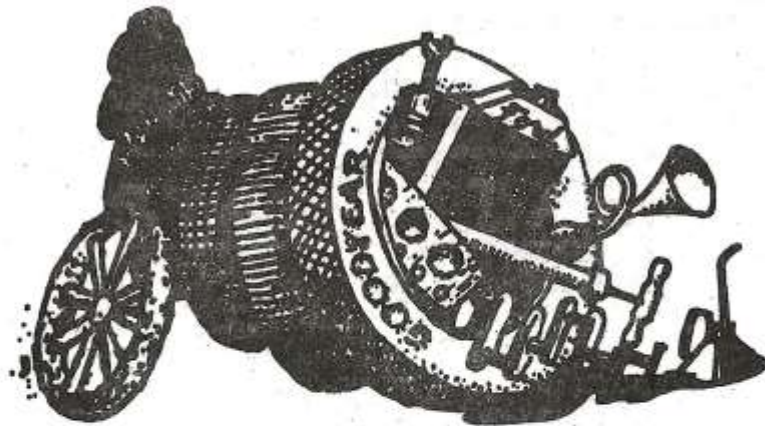
Otherwise, be in Prosser before the 10AM parade start time.
