I don't know how this went, I gave up trying to get information from the Chamber of Commerce.

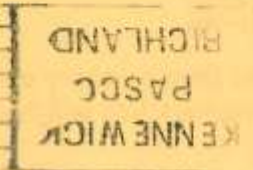
## Bruce & Suzie Stinsman have moved north to Alaska.
